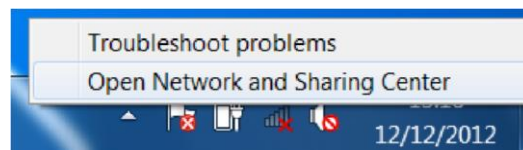


Manually Configuring eduroam

-- Windows 7

1. On your **Desktop**, right-click on the wireless icon located in the System Tray on the bottom right of the screen, and click **Open Network and Sharing Center**



2. Select **Set up a new connection or network**

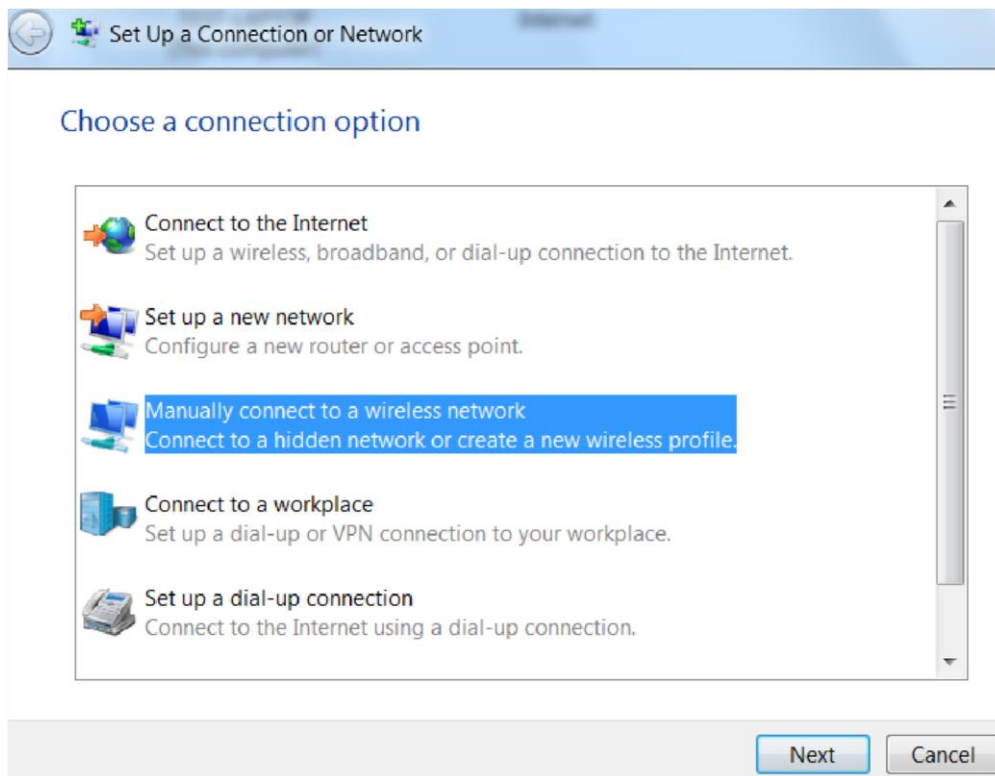
Set up a wireless, broadband, dial-up, ad hoc, or VPN connection; or set up a router or access point.



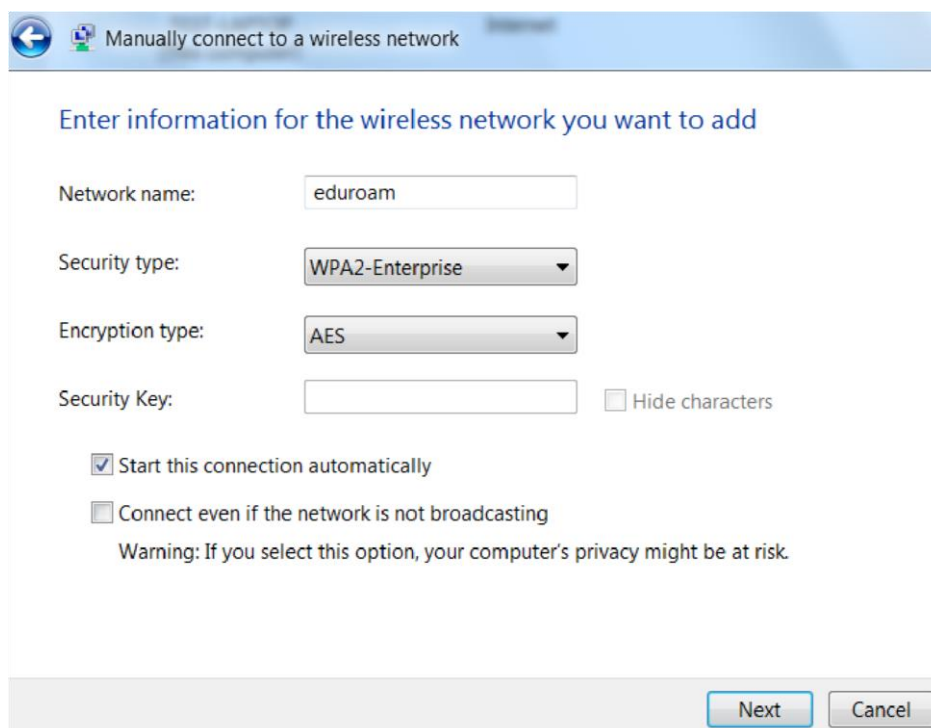

3. Select **Manually connect to a wireless network**



4. Enter the details as shown below, then click **Next**



5. Click **Change connection settings**

6. Select the **Security** tab. Under **Choose a network authentication method**: make sure **Microsoft: Protected EAP (PEAP)** is selected and the other settings match those below. Then click **Settings**

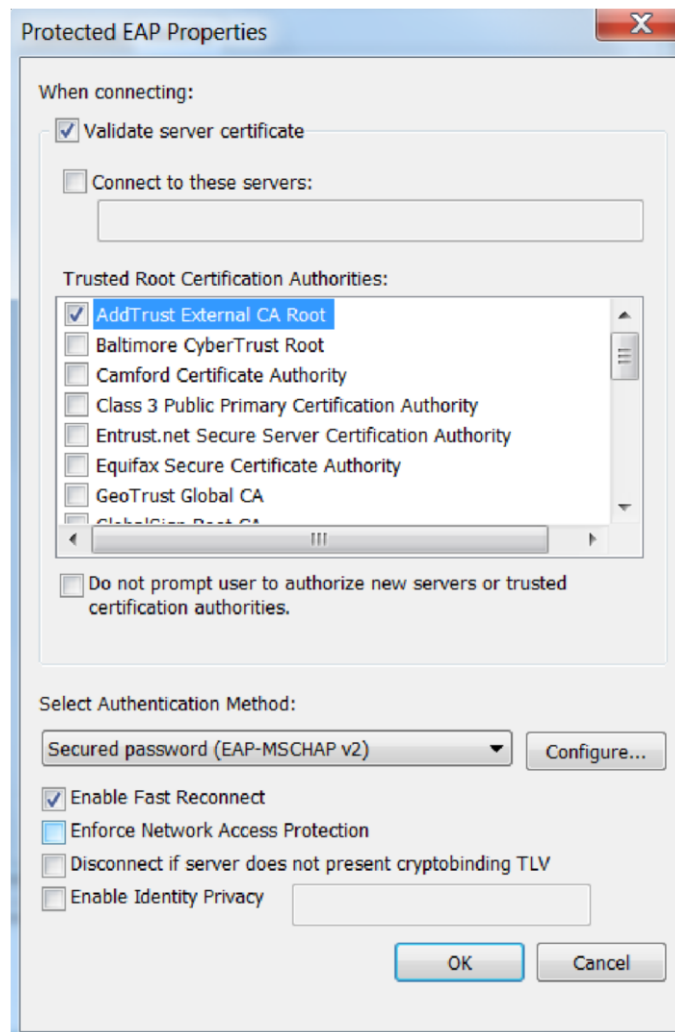

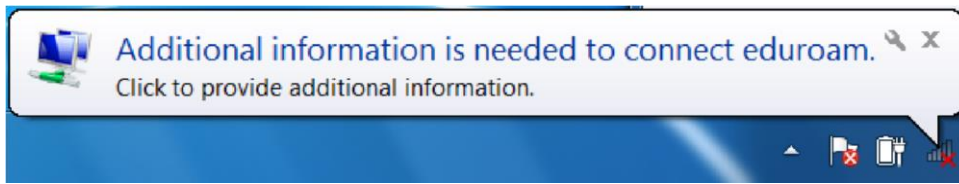
7. In the **Protected EAP Properties** screen, complete the details as below, making sure to tick the box next to **AddTrust External CA Root**.



8. To the right of **Secured password (EAP-MSCHAP v2)** click **Configure..**. Make sure the box in the popup window is *unchecked* as shown. Then click OK/Close until all windows are closed and you are back at your desktop.




9. Assuming you are in range of the **eduroam** network, your computer should now attempt to connect, but will tell you that additional information is required. When this appears, click on the message.



10. A popup box should now appear for authentication details. Enter your username and password based on the format below. If you are unsure of your username, contact your campus IT helpdesk.
